THE ENGINE OF GLOBAL APPAREL MANUFACTURING ENTERING ITS NEXT GROWTH PHASE

Every major apparel brand looks to Bangladesh—not simply because of its manufacturing scale, but because it has built one of the world's strongest apparel ecosystems, supported by experienced manufacturers, a skilled workforce, competitive production capabilities and an ever-evolving textile industry.

With US\$ 38.70 billion in RMG exports in FY2025–26, Bangladesh remains one of the world's leading apparel manufacturing hubs. RMG contributes 80%+ of total export earnings, while the textile sector contributes approximately 11% of GDP and directly employs more than 4 million people. With over 4,500 garment factories and exports reaching more than 150 countries, Bangladesh continues to attract global brands seeking reliable, large-scale and increasingly sophisticated production capabilities.

But Bangladesh's next growth story is no longer just about scale—it is about diversification, innovation and value addition.

During H1 FY2025–26, MMF-based garment exports grew 14.1% to US\$ 3.68 billion, taking MMF's share to a record 19%, compared with 11.4% for full-year 2024. As Bangladesh targets US\$100 billion in apparel exports by 2030, with MMF expected to account for 40% of RMG exports, sourcing requirements are rapidly expanding beyond traditional cotton towards man-made fibres, functional textiles, performance wear, sustainable materials and higher-value products.

This is where Intex Bangladesh comes in.
