A: Our sons and daughters are coming back from abroad with ideas and energy. They're excited to grow the business. We should support them to lead global growth from Bangladesh.

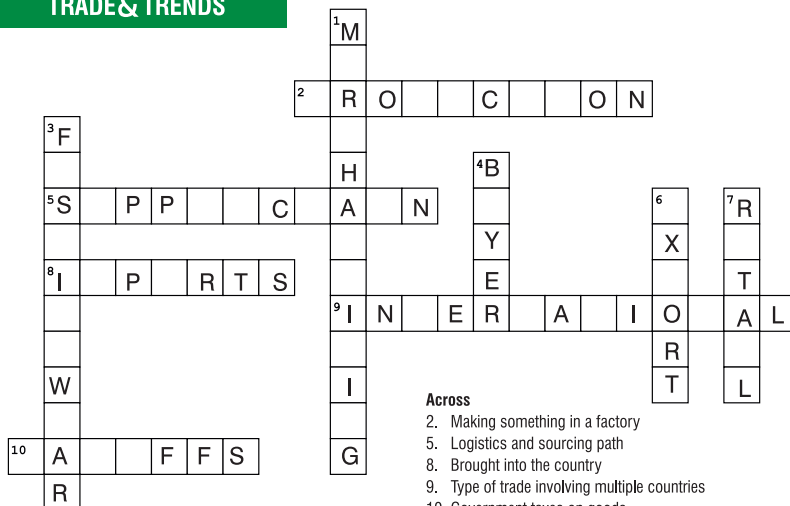
Q: You've been a regular visitor at Intex. How do you see its role in shaping the industry?
