Intex Bangladesh 2025 to Strengthen Industry Partnerships and Expand Global Sourcing Access

[Dhaka, Bangladesh, 16 June, 2025] As the garments sector of Bangladesh continues to move towards higher value products and more global integration, Intex Bangladesh returns to Dhaka this June with its renewed purpose and strong international backing. The three-day exhibition, scheduled for 25–27 June 2025 at the International Convention City Bashundhara (ICCB), is likely to feature Bangladesh’s growing role and leadership in the global textile and apparel trade arena.

Organized by Worldex India Exhibition & Promotion Pvt. Ltd., Intex is poised to stage a comeback in the form of the 16th edition as South Asia’s most prestigious international textile sourcing fair with its foundation deeply rooted in Bangladesh. Over the last few years, the fair has played an instrumental role in driving the region’s textile and apparel sector—serving as a meeting point of hundreds of exhibitors and thousands of genuine trade buyers. By facilitating high-value business deals, Intex continues to play a significant part in Bangladesh’s export growth and industrialization.

With Bangladesh now recognised as the world’s second-largest apparel exporter, the focus has steadily shifted from volume to value—emphasising sustainability, functionality, and product excellence. Intex Bangladesh 2025 is aligned with this transition, bringing together high-quality suppliers, manufacturers, and innovators from Asia and beyond who are ready to meet the evolving needs of Bangladesh’s RMG sector. The show will host a diverse product portfolio from global sourcing hubs. Exhibitors from India will present cotton and blended fabrics, yarns, functional textiles, embroidery, laces, jacquards, digital prints, and sustainable fibres. From China, trade visitors and buyers can expect synthetic and technical fabrics, warp knits and embroidery fabrics, outerwear textiles, trims, and fashion accessories. South Korea will contribute seam tape, adhesive film and deco film for the garment industry. From Thailand and Japan, companies will showcase premium shirting and suiting fabrics, circular knits, innovative collagen 100% biodegradable fabrics and woven innovations. And most importantly, Bangladeshi companies will showcase performance fabrics, high quality yarns, chemicals, certifications & compliance solutions and marketplace.

Intex Bangladesh 2025 positions itself as a strategic platform where sourcing meets strategy. It is tailored for professionals across design, merchandising, product development, and supply chain management, offering access to curated business interactions and market intelligence via Interactive Business Forum to be held alongside the exhibition. This edition will further support the country’s move up the value chain with a focus on fashion-forward, eco-conscious, and innovation-led materials and practices.

Endorsed by some of the most influential industry and bilateral organisations, the 2025 edition enjoys the support of the Bangladesh Garment Manufacturers & Exporters Association (BGMEA), Bangladesh Knitwear Manufacturers & Exporters Association (BKMEA), Bangladesh-German Chamber of Commerce & Industry (BGCCI), US-Bangladesh Chamber of Commerce & Industry (USBCCI), Latin America Bangladesh Chamber of Commerce & Industry (LABCCI), Korea-Bangladesh Chamber of Commerce & Industry (KBCCI), India-Bangladesh Chamber of Commerce & Industry (IBCCI), and EuroCham Bangladesh, among others. These partnerships reinforce Intex’s role as a bridge between Bangladesh and the global textile economy, cultivating long-term sourcing relationships and collaborative growth.

প্রেস বিজ্ঞপ্তি

১৬তম ইন্টেক্স বাংলাদেশ এক্সিবিশন আয়োজনে প্রস্তুত ঢাকা

[ঢাকা, বাংলাদেশ, ১৬ জুন ২০২৫] দেশের তৈরি পোশাকখাতে সংশ্লিষ্ট উচ্চ মূল্য সংযোজিত পণ্য ও বৈশ্বিক একীভূতকরণের লক্ষ্যমাত্রা ত্বরান্বিত করার উদ্দেশ্যে সুসংহত আন্তর্জাতিক সমর্থন নিয়ে আবারও ঢাকায় অনুষ্ঠিত হতে যাচ্ছে ১৬তম ইন্টেক্স বাংলাদেশ এক্সিবিশন ২০২৫। রাজধানীর ইন্টারন্যাশনাল কনভেনশন সিটি বসুন্ধরা (আইসিসিবি)-তে আগামী ২৫ জুন শুরু হয়ে তিন দিনব্যাপী এই আয়োজন চলবে ২৭ জুন পর্যন্ত। এবারের আয়োজনটি বৈশ্বিক টেক্সটাইল ও অ্যাপারেল বাণিজ্যে বাংলাদেশের ক্রমবর্ধমান নেতৃত্ব ও গুরুত্বকে আরও জোরালোভাবে তুলে ধরবে।

বিগত কয়েক বছর ধরে এই মেলা দেশের টেক্সটাইল ও গার্মেন্টস শিল্পের বিকাশে গুরুত্বপূর্ণ ভূমিকা রেখে আসছে। দক্ষিণ এশিয়ার অন্যতম মর্যাদাপূর্ণ আন্তর্জাতিক টেক্সটাইল সোর্সিং মেলা আরো বৃহৎ পরিসরে উপস্থাপনে কাজ করছে ইন্টেক্স এক্সিবিশনের আয়োজক ওয়ার্ল্ডেক্স ইন্ডিয়া এক্সিবিশন অ্যান্ড প্রমোশন প্রাইভেট লিমিটেড। শতাধিক প্রদর্শক ও হাজারো ব্যবসায়িক ক্রেতাদের একত্রিত করে ইন্টেক্স বাংলাদেশ উচ্চমূল্যের ব্যবসায়িক চুক্তি সম্পাদনে সহায়ক ভূমিকা পালন করছে, যা দেশের রপ্তানি প্রবৃদ্ধি ও শিল্পায়নে শক্তিশালী অবদান রেখে চলেছে।

বিশ্বের দ্বিতীয় বৃহত্তম পোশাক রপ্তানিকারক দেশ হিসেবে বাংলাদেশ তৈরি পোশাক শিল্পখাতকে শুধুমাত্র উৎপাদনের পরিমাণে নয়, বরং মান, টেকসইতা ও পণ্যের উৎকর্ষতার দিকে গুরুত্ব দিচ্ছে। ইন্টেক্স বাংলাদেশ ২০২৫ এই রূপান্তরের সাথে সুসংগত, যেখানে এশিয়া ও অন্যান্য দেশের শীর্ষস্থানীয় সরবরাহকারী, নির্মাতা এবং উদ্ভাবকরা বাংলাদেশের তৈরি পোশাক খাতের পরিবর্তনশীল চাহিদা পূরণে প্রস্তুত।

এই এক্সপোতে বাংলাদেশি কোম্পানিগুলি তুলে ধরবে পারফরমেন্স ফেব্রিক্স, উচ্চমানের সুতা, কেমিক্যাল, সার্টিফিকেশন ও কমপ্লায়েন্স সলিউশন এবং স্থানীয় মার্কেটপ্লেসের সেবা। প্রদর্শনীতে ভারত থেকে অংশগ্রহণকারীরা তুলা ও ব্লেন্ডেড ফেব্রিক্স, সুতা, ফ্যাংশনাল টেক্সটাইল, এমব্রয়ডারি, লেইস, জাকার্ড, ডিজিটাল প্রিন্ট ও টেকসই ফাইবার উপস্থাপন করবে। চীন থেকে আসা প্রদর্শকদের পণ্যসমূহের মধ্যে থাকবে সিনথেটিক ও টেকনিক্যাল ফেব্রিক্স, ওয়ার্প নিটস, এমব্রয়ডারি ফেব্রিক্স, আউটারওয়্যার টেক্সটাইল, ট্রিমস ও ফ্যাশন এক্সেসরিজ। দক্ষিণ কোরিয়া থেকে থাকবে সিম টেপ, অ্যাডহেসিভ ফিল্ম ও গার্মেন্ট ইন্ডাস্ট্রির জন্য ডেকো ফিল্ম। থাইল্যান্ড ও জাপানের কোম্পানিগুলি প্রদর্শন করবে প্রিমিয়াম শাট্টিং ও সুটিং ফেব্রিক্স, সার্কুলার নিটস, উদ্ভাবনী ১০০% বায়োডিগ্রেডেবল কোলাজেন ফেব্রিক্স এবং উন্নতমানের বোনা পণ্য।

ইন্টেক্স বাংলাদেশ ২০২৫ এমন একটি কৌশলগত প্ল্যাটফর্ম হিসেবে নিজেকে উপস্থাপন করছে যেখানে সোর্সিং ও স্ট্র্যাটেজির মিলন ঘটে। ডিজাইন, মার্চেন্টাইজিং, পণ্য উন্নয়ন এবং সাপ্লাই চেইন ম্যানেজমেন্টের পেশাজীবীদের জন্য এই মেলা গুরুত্বপূর্ণ সুযোগ নিয়ে আসছে। প্রদর্শনীর পাশাপাশি আয়োজন করা হবে ইন্টারঅ্যাক্টিভ বিজনেস ফোরাম, যেখানে মিলবে ব্যবসায়িক মতবিনিময়ের সুযোগ ও মূল্যবান মার্কেট ইনটেলিজেন্স। এবারের আসর বিশেষভাবে বাংলাদেশের ফ্যাশন-ফোকাসড, পরিবেশ-বান্ধব ও উদ্ভাবন-নির্ভর শিল্প উন্নয়নকে উৎসাহিত করবে।

ইতোমধ্যে বাংলাদেশের গার্মেন্টস শিল্পের শীর্ষ সংগঠন ও বিভিন্ন আন্তর্জাতিক দ্বিপাক্ষিক চেম্বারের সমর্থন অর্জন করেছে ইন্টেক্স বাংলাদেশ ২০২৫। এর মধ্যে রয়েছে বাংলাদেশ গার্মেন্ট ম্যানুফ্যাকচারারস অ্যান্ড এক্সপোর্টারস অ্যাসোসিয়েশন (বিজিএমইএ), বাংলাদেশ নীটওয়ারার ম্যানুফ্যাকচারারস অ্যান্ড এক্সপোর্টারস অ্যাসোসিয়েশন (বিকেএমইএ), বাংলাদেশ-জার্মান চেম্বার অফ কমার্স অ্যান্ড ইন্ডাস্ট্রি (বিজিসিসিআই), ইউএস-বাংলাদেশ চেম্বার অফ কমার্স অ্যান্ড ইন্ডাস্ট্রি (ইউএসবিসিসিআই), ল্যাটিন আমেরিকা বাংলাদেশ চেম্বার অফ কমার্স অ্যান্ড ইন্ডাস্ট্রি (এলএবিসিসিআই), কোরিয়া-বাংলাদেশ চেম্বার অফ কমার্স অ্যান্ড ইন্ডাস্ট্রি (কেবিসিসিআই), ইন্ডিয়া-বাংলাদেশ চেম্বার অফ কমার্স অ্যান্ড ইন্ডাস্ট্রি (আইবিসিসিআই) এবং ইউরোচ্যাম বাংলাদেশ। এই অংশীদারিত্ব ইন্টেক্সের বৈশ্বিক টেক্সটাইল অর্থনীতির সাথে বাংলাদেশের দীর্ঘমেয়াদী সংযোগের গুরুত্বকে আরও শক্তিশালী করে তুলছে।

ইন্টেক্সের এই বেড়ে ওঠা সফলতার কেন্দ্রবিন্দুতে রয়েছে একটি সুদূরপ্রসারী লক্ষ্য, যেখানে বাংলাদেশ কেবলমাত্র একটি সরবরাহকারী দেশ নয়, বরং একটি কৌশলগত উৎপাদন ও উদ্ভাবনের অংশীদার হিসেবে নিজেদের প্রতিষ্ঠিত করছে। ওয়ার্ল্ডেক্স ইন্ডিয়া -এর এক্সিকিউটিভ ডিরেক্টর আরতি ভগত বলেন, "ইন্টেক্স বাংলাদেশের মাধ্যমে আমাদের লক্ষ্য হচ্ছে শিল্পকে উচ্চমানের সরবরাহকারী, বৈচিত্র্যময় পণ্য উদ্ভাবন এবং দীর্ঘমেয়াদী সহযোগিতার সুযোগের মাধ্যমে সমৃদ্ধ করা। আজ এই প্ল্যাটফর্মটি এমন একটি বিশ্বস্ত জায়গায় পরিণত হয়েছে, যেখানে বাংলাদেশ কেবলমাত্র একজন সরবরাহকারী নয়, বরং একজন কৌশলগত অংশীদার হিসেবেও বিশ্ববাজারের সাথে আত্মবিশ্বাসের সাথে কাজ করতে পারে।"

বাংলাদেশ যখন তার রপ্তানি সক্ষমতা আরও বাড়াচ্ছে এবং ভবিষ্যতমুখী সোর্সিং পদ্ধতি গ্রহণ করছে, তখন ইন্টেক্স বাংলাদেশ ২০২৫ সেই উপযুক্ত পরিবেশ তৈরি করছে যেখানে নতুন সুযোগ উন্মোচিত হবে, আঞ্চলিক ও বৈশ্বিক অংশীদারিত্ব গড়ে উঠবে এবং বাংলাদেশের তৈরি পোশাক খাতে উচ্চতর সাফল্যের পথ সুগম হবে।

16th Intex: A Resounding Success for the Textile & Apparel Industry of Bangladesh

The 16th edition of Intex was held from 25 to 27 June 2025 at the International Convention City Bashundhara (ICCB), Dhaka, Bangladesh concluded on a high note, marking yet another successful chapter in South Asia's premier international textile sourcing platform.

The Grand Opening Ceremony on 25th June welcomed esteemed dignitaries, trade associations, bilateral chambers, and international exhibitors in a celebration of Bangladesh's dynamic and evolving textile and apparel sector. The event began with a welcome speech by Ms. Arti Bhagat, Executive Director, Worldex India. The ceremony was inaugurated by Mr. Mahbubur Rahman, Secretary, Ministry of Commerce, as Chief Guest, along with Mr. Md. Anwar Hossain, Vice-Chairman, EPB, as Guest of Honour. Also addressing the gathering were Mr. Amal Poddar, Sr. Vice President, BKMEA; Mr. Faisal Samad, Sr. Vice President, BGMEA; Mr. A.K.M. Saifur Rahman, Vice President, BGBA; and Mr. Murali Balkrishna, Joint Director, TEXPROCIL. The inauguration was also attended by the presidents of key bilateral bodies — LABCCI, KBCCI, BGCCI, and USBCCI, and concluded with felicitation, group photography, ribbon cutting, a VIP tour of the exhibition, and closing remarks by Mr. Rajesh Bhagat, Chairman & MD, Worldex India.

This year's exhibition brought together exhibitors from 10+ countries, including India, China, South Korea, Thailand, Japan, Germany and Bangladesh, showcasing a rich array of textile innovations — from sustainable yarns, performance fabrics, trims and accessories, to denim, knits and digital prints. The strong participation from Bangladesh-based companies further underscored the country's growing confidence as a global sourcing hub. Intex Bangladesh 2025 attracted 6,890 trade buyers and visitors, with delegations and sourcing representatives from 22+ countries, such as Canada, France, Germany, India, Indonesia, Italy, Japan, Korea, China, Bahrain, Malaysia, Mexico, Netherlands, Poland, Saudi Arabia, Spain, Sri Lanka, Sweden, Turkey, the UK, the UAE, the USA, and Uzbekistan. The show facilitated hundreds of high-level meetings and curated buyer-seller interactions, helping create long-term, strategic sourcing partnerships across borders.

The knowledge-sharing platform of the show — the Interactive Business Forum (IBF) — hosted two impactful sessions. On Day 1 (26th June), the panel on “AI & Adaptability of Technology: Reinventing the Fabric of Tomorrow” explored how AI is transforming the textile value chain — from design and prototyping to demand forecasting, sustainability, and smart manufacturing. The panel featured Mr. Minhazul Hoque (BKMEA), Mr. Abrar Hossain Sayem (BAYLA), Mr. Ahsan Mahmood (Nordic Sourcing), Ms. Aurélie Rob (Otto International), and Mr. Md. Mahbubur Rahman (R&G 3rd Eye), moderated by Mr. Mohammad Monower Hossain (TEAM Group). The session emphasized industry-wide collaboration for AI adoption, resilience, and traceability.

On Day 2 (27th June), the session “Tariffs & Industry Outlook: Unlocking the Risks & Opportunities” addressed rising tariff challenges, shifting trade dynamics, and strategic responses for Bangladesh's RMG sector. The panel included Mr. Mohammed Sohel (BGMEA), Mr. AKM Saifur Rahman Farhad (BGBA), Mr. Mohammad Sohel Sadat (Shin Shin Group), Mr. Md Jasim Uddin (Texture BD / BAYLA), and Mr. Masud Kabir (Motex Fashion), moderated by Mr. Azam Saiful (TJS Consultants). The discussion stressed the need for export diversification, policy alignment, and smarter strategies to maintain global competitiveness.

Throughout the three-day event, Intex Bangladesh emerged not only as a sourcing platform but as a strategic enabler of industry transformation. From connecting global suppliers with local manufacturers to fostering dialogue on AI, sustainability, and trade dynamics, the show served as a vital bridge between vision and action.

The feedback from both exhibitors and buyers was overwhelmingly positive, praising the scale, quality, and business potential of the event. Most of the exhibitors expressed appreciation for the high-quality buyer interactions, while Bangladeshi stakeholders acknowledged the show's contribution in elevating Bangladesh's global image as a responsible, innovative, and future-ready sourcing hub.

As the curtains fall on yet another powerful edition of Intex in Bangladesh, we extend our heartfelt thanks to all the dignitaries, partners, chambers, exhibitors, buyers, media, and participants who made this event a resounding success. Intex Bangladesh continues to fuel the region's textile growth story, and we look forward to welcoming the industry back in June 2026 with even more innovation, collaboration, and global ambition.

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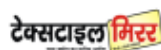

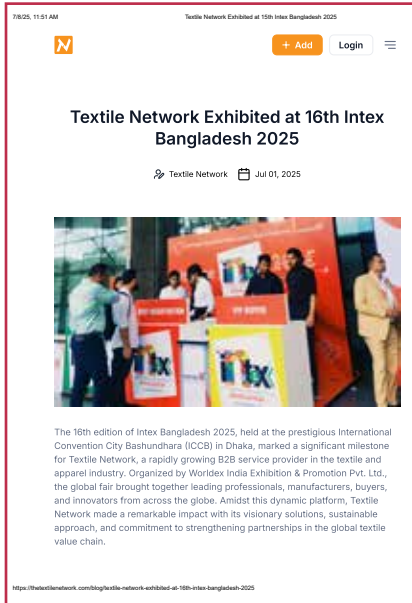
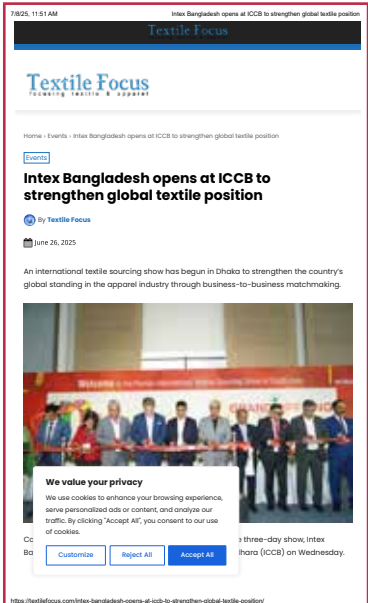
